After being very happy with the MSV Hex 1.10 already, this string also convinced me right from the start. After the first 2 hours of singles I immediately ordered a reel. The string fits my playing style and racquet (16x18) perfectly. I used to play only multifilaments for over 15 years.. and I could not imagine enjoying a poly so much. I will use this string during the summer season in my team matches. After playing the string for more than 16 hours now, including 4 hours on clay last weekend, my first impression was confirmed. My clear favorite in the poly department. All characteristics are great. Even recommendable for players with arm problems. This string gives me great confidence. It maintains its characteristics even after +16 hours. After stringing I measured 25 kg with a Stringmeter and MiniSTT. After 2 hours of play 23.5 kg. After 16 hours of play 21.22 kg.</p>
